ASSIGNMENTS IN JUVENILE  
DELINQUENCY, JUVENILE  
DEPENDENCY, TPO AND CHILD  
SUPPORT CASES.

Administrative Order: 20-15

The Chief Judge is responsible for supervising the administrative business of the Eighth Judicial District Court, ensuring the quality and continuity of its services, supervising its calendar, reassigning cases as convenience or necessity requires, assuring the court's duties are timely and orderly performed and otherwise facilitating the business of the District Court. NRS 3.025; *see also* EDCR 1.30(b).

This Court has previously issued administrative orders relevant to juvenile delinquency and dependency cases, and intends to modify the current assignments to further foster consistency, efficiency, and fairness.

Accordingly pursuant to Rule 1.30(b), effective May 4, 2020:

50% of the open, closed and future juvenile delinquency cases will be randomly assigned to Department L. Department A will hear juvenile delinquency cases on Mondays and Wednesdays; Department L will hear juvenile delinquency cases on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Hearing Master William Croft will continue to assist with the Department A delinquency cases. Hearing Master Croft will continue to be assigned the restitution calendar. Hearing Master Soonhee Bailey will be assigned to assist with the Department L delinquency cases. Hearing Master Bailey will continue to be assigned the DAAY Court, which will be overseen by the Department L Judge.

1 All Juvenile Sex Offense trials and evidentiary hearings are to be heard by the assigned  
2 district court judge.

4 Hearing Master Holly Roys will be reassigned to the TPO division. The cases currently  
5 handled by Hearing Master Roys will be randomly reassigned 50% each to Departments A and  
6 L.


7 The Department L Civil Domestic cases will be covered by senior judges or other district  
8 court judges until further notice.

9 Effective immediately, Hearing Master Amy Mastin will be reassigned to the Child  
10 Support Division.

11 Court Administration shall publish the list of cases affected by the reassignments  
12 mentioned above on the EJDC website.

13 This Administrative Order shall supersede any prior AO regarding these assignments.
